## (some of) WHAT GENTING ISN'T TELLING YOU

- Tuxedo residents who are connected to United Water New York will experience more frequent
  drought warnings and longer drought emergencies in the future. The Sterling Forest Resort
  Casino will use a large portion of the remaining available supply from the Indian Kill Reservoir.
  Drought warnings and emergencies are based on water levels in the reservoir. These water levels
  will decline more rapidly after the casino is connected to the reservoir, thereby triggering these
  warnings and emergencies at a greater rate of recurrence and for longer periods of time.
- Increased drought warnings and emergencies mean that United Water New York customers will need to reduce water use more frequently and they will need to do so for greater lengths of time. Lawn irrigation, car washing, and other non-essential uses of water will be totally curtailed at times. Some businesses that use large amounts of water may need to cease operation.
- Water surcharges may be imposed if more than minimum amounts of water are used by regular customers.
- New developments beyond Sterling Forest Resort may require the need to develop additional
  water supplies and to expand existing water supply infrastructure. Since these water supplies and
  their related infrastructure will be required to meet new State and Federal standards, in
  conjunction with the fact that existing water supplies are limited, United Water New York
  customers can expect to pay substantially greater costs for their potable water supply needs.
- Flows in the Indian Kill Creek and the Ramapo River will be significantly reduced once the casino is built. Fishing and other recreational opportunities will suffer.
